

Count different Sudoku

Place a digit from 1 to 9 into each of the empty squares so that each digit appears exactly once in each of the rows, columns and the nine outlined 3x3 regions.

Arrows and numbers outside gridding means how many different numbers in corresponding direction grid.



(Solution)

The grid is a 9x9 Sudoku puzzle. The numbers already present in the grid are:

Arrows and numbers outside the grid indicate the count of different numbers in each row, column, and 3x3 region:

- Row 1: 3 (above column 4), 5 (above column 5), 5 (above column 6)
- Row 2: 5 (left of column 1), 4 (left of column 2), 4 (left of column 3)
- Row 3: 2 (right of column 9), 3 (right of column 9), 5 (right of column 9)
- Row 4: 4 (below column 4), 3 (below column 5), 4 (below column 6)

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
