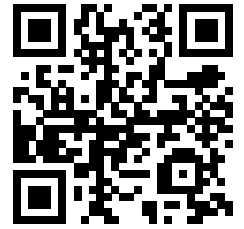


Mathras Sudoku



1 9 3x3 Mathras Sudoku puzzle. The grid contains numbers 1-9 and mathematical symbols (+, -, x, /) in various cells. The goal is to solve the puzzle by applying mathematical operations to the numbers.

The puzzle is a 9x9 grid divided into 3x3 sub-grids. Each row, column, and sub-grid must contain the numbers 1 through 9 exactly once. Additionally, mathematical operations (+, -, x, /) are placed in some cells, and the numbers in those cells must satisfy the operation. For example, if a cell contains '9+', it means the sum of the numbers in the adjacent cells must equal 9.
