

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
Thermo Sudoku

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

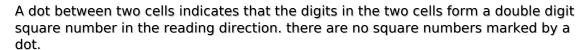

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
MiniMax Sudoku

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Hybrid Sudoku (Consecutive Pairs + Sum Frame)



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
Greater Than Kropki Sudoku

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
X Sums Sudoku

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
Makodoku
